BOARD OF CANVASS**

March 12, 2009

Present – Supervisors Jeff Holm, Lester Kriesel, Bryan Lawrence, Jim Oliver and Paul Vollkommer.

Call to Order – Chairman Bryan Lawrence called the Baldwin Township Board of Canvass meeting to order at 8:03 a.m.

Pledge of Allegiance – All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Canvass Election Results – For the Baldwin Township Supervisor “A” position, candidate Larry Handshoe received 170 votes. Candidate Cal Schmock received 34 votes. Candidate Paul Vollkommer received 134 votes. Two under votes were cast. Total of 340 votes cast. The election results were signed by all election judges: Kimberly Good, Sharon J. Matz, Joyce Mueller, Llona Jorgenson and Nancy P. Dorweiler.

Kriesel/Oliver unanimous to accept the election results for Supervisor “A”.

For the Baldwin Township Supervisor “E” position, candidate Lester W. Kriesel received 149 votes. Candidate Jay Swanson received 184 votes. Seven under votes were cast. Total of 340 votes cast. The election results were signed by all election judges: Kimberly Good, Sharon J. Matz, Joyce Mueller, Llona Jorgenson and Nancy P. Dorweiler.

Oliver/Vollkommer unanimous to accept the election results for Supervisor “E”.

For the ballot questions: “Shall option C, providing for the appointment of a town administrator by the town board, be adopted for the government of the town?” There were 238 no votes cast and 102 yes votes. The election results were signed by all election judges: Kimberly Good, Sharon J. Matz, Joyce Mueller, Llona Jorgenson and Nancy P. Dorweiler.

Oliver/Vollkommer unanimous to accept the results for ballot question “C”.
