





There are specific hours for burning and a burning permit must be obtained. Please call the Baldwin Town Hall for the names and phone numbers of the fire wardens or check the list which is always posted on the town hall window.

It is never permissible to burn garbage.

Recreational fires do not need a permit.

Burning is never allowed in the township right-of-way or on the township road.

Spring and Summer Reminders

RIGHT-OF-WAY: Remember, please do not plant or place things in the township right-of-way area. The right-of-way area is usually 33 feet from the center of the road. This also includes agricultural land; some crops can reduce visibility, and fill in the ditches, which may cause ditch repair in the future. We do encourage you to mow the right-of-way areas. If you have questions, give us a call. We will be glad to come and meet with you.
