**RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE BALDWIN TOWNSHIP EMERGENCY MANAGERS,
PRIMARY AND SECONDARY, DURING THE COVID-19 COUNTY DECLARED
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020 the Sherburne County, State of Minnesota, Sheriff's Office activated its Emergency Operations Center in response to the COVID-19 outbreak;

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020 Sherburne County, declared a state of emergency related to the transmission of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and its resulting illness for 72 hours;

WHEREAS, Sherburne County extended the declaration on March 20, 2020;

WHEREAS, as of this date no cities in Sherburne County have declared an emergency;


WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a viral respiratory illness caused by novel coronavirus and is potentially fatal and known to spread rapidly among populations without preventative measures;

WHEREAS, designating a Town Emergency Manager will allow the Town to have representation on the Sherburne County Emergency Operations Center meeting which meets thrice weekly (which the Town currently does not have);

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Baldwin Township Board of Supervisors hereby appoint the Baldwin Township Chairman, Jay Swanson, as Primary Emergency Manager and Vice-Chairman Tom Rush as Secondary Emergency Manager.
