Cars could be lined up along the split rail fencing with potential overflow along the edge of the ballfield and behind the playground equipment, if necessary, as long as the grass was mowed. The food vendor will be placed in front of the brown building, and the musicians in the pavilion. The Bouncy House can be set up west of the brown building as well as various smaller children's games throughout the grassy area in front of the brown building.

- Frank King and Dick Dobson will solicit for donations from the area businesses. There are T-Shirts and water bottles from past FunFest events that could also be given as 'door prizes'.
