**Financial Report** – The Expense and Income for FunFest 2018 was reviewed showing an ending balance of negative \$143.85. After discussing a dollar amount Liaison Rush indicated that he would motion to line item \$1000 from the Park Fund for the FunFest at the regular meeting of Baldwin Township scheduled March 4, 2019.

**Approve / Disapprove Meeting Dates** – It was approved that the Baldwin Volunteer Corps will meet on the fourth Monday of each month except for May and September. The May meeting will be on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 and the September meeting will be Monday, September 30, 2019. If needed additional meetings may be scheduled. Normally the Baldwin Volunteer Corps does not meet in October, November and December.

**Discuss Ideas / Events for 2019** – Even though County Road 38 road construction is scheduled to start in March 2019 with a construction end date of September 9, 2019 there was discussion whether that timeline would be altered because of the amount of snow and potential flooding when the snow melts which potentially would delay the end date. The FunFest had already been scheduled for Saturday, September 14, 2019. At this time the committee has decided to go ahead and make plans for the FunFest, and to keep that date for the festivities.

Lack of volunteers is always a problem. Ideas for volunteers to help with the FunFest are the Park Committee members, and teens from both the football team and the Teen Center.
