The estimated number of people attending was around the 125 mark. The number of registered cars was 16. The unusually hot weather may have been a factor; although there were several other car shows going on in the area also. It was suggested that two flyers be created for next year. One to advertise the FunFest along with the children's games; the second to advertise the car show. It was also suggested to have the flyers prepared and available to the public 4 to 5 months ahead of the event for maximum coverage. Contacting the MSRA (MN Street Rod Association) also may help promote.

There were no Scouts or members of the football team who showed up to volunteer with the games. It was suggested that the Princeton Teen Center's coordinator Vicky Hallin be contacted next year to see if any of the kids are interested in earning volunteer hours.
