Call to Order – The March 11, 2015 Baldwin Township Board of Canvass was called to order by Chairman Jay Swanson at 4:57 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance - All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

With guidance from the Sherburne County Auditor's office, the Board of Canvass met to re-certify the election results as the race for Supervisor 'E' was 3 votes off for the write-in votes. In order to comply with Minnesota State Statute 205.185, subdv. 3, the Board of Canvass met. Notice of this meeting was posted on the town hall window and website.

Re-Canvass Election Results - The results for Supervisor 'E' that was canvassed March 10, 2015 immediately following the Annual Meeting was listed as:
Candidate Chuck Nagle received 60 votes. Candidate Jay Swanson received 149 votes. Write-in Larry Handshoe received 10 votes; write-in Jeremy Linde received 1 vote; write-in Craig Thompson received 1 vote; write-in Kim Good received 1 vote. There were no overvotes and the undervotes were 12 votes. Total votes cast were 231 votes.


The corrected results were as follows: Candidate Chuck Nagle received 60 votes. Candidate Jay Swanson received 149 votes. Write-in Larry Handshoe received 7 votes; write-in Jeremy Linde received 1 vote; write-in Craig Thompson received 1 vote; write-in Kim Good received 1 vote. There were no overvotes and the undervotes were 12 votes. Total votes cast were 231 votes.
