

**BALDWIN PARK COMMITTEE
JOINT MEETING WITH THE BALDWIN TOWN BOARD**

May 16, 2013

Present - Baldwin Park Committee members: Dave Patten, Mark Fredrickson, Jeremy Peterson, Lester Kriesel and Wayne Thompson. Baldwin Town Board Supervisors: Jay Swanson, Tom Rush (also Park Committee Liaison), Randy Atwood, Larry Handshoe and Kimberly Good.

Call Meeting to Order – The May 16, 2013 Baldwin Park Committee meeting was called to order by Dave Patten at 7:06 p.m.

Meet with Town Board Regarding Park Pavilion – Supervisor Swanson presented drawings that he had prepared as “food for thought only”. One response from the public was received. One question is does the board want to put the pavilion where the white building was or closer to the shade and playground. Dave Patten stated that the piece of concrete will not go to waste as a basketball hoop could be placed there. Regarding the bid already received from Latcham, Patten stated that the committee wanted to get a ballpark price. Swanson stated that it may be possible to have 2 pavilions. Patten replied that the committee was thinking of more of a shade sail near the playground area as it would be fairly inexpensive. Discussion regarding having the pavilion either on the existing concrete or adding onto the brown building and maintenance costs. Discussion regarding obtaining resident input at the next park event scheduled for June 22, 2013. Patten stated that he will try to get a 3 dimensional look of it and sketch it out and obtain public comment. There should be some type of announcement in the paper about the event. Tom Rush stated that he would like to see the pavilion get going in July. Get the boardwalks in and get the pavilion done. Discussion regarding the rock monument and possibly utilizing Sentence to Serve for the boardwalk installation. Randy Atwood questioned if the committee had looked at hiring out the labor for the installation. Patten replied that he knows of a contractor that could come out and get it done within a week. Swanson stated that he would like to see the boardwalks done before the pavilion is started. He also knows of a person who could install the boardwalks and then the town board would have two quotes.

The date of June 8, 2013 at 8:00 a.m. was determined to start installing the boardwalks. Several volunteers were in the audience and the deputy clerk will send out an email to other volunteers along with adding it to the township website, Facebook page and posting. Coffee and donuts will be provided. It was determined that someone needs to go to the park and see what lumber is out there and Marv's True Value still has a stack of lumber that has the township's name on it. Rebar still needs to be purchased.

Rush stated that, at the next Park Committee in June, the committee needs to look at what rules need to be placed on a large sign in the park. Discussion regarding the Sandy Lake south access. Discussion regarding the old swing sets along with the possibility of another playground set available from another municipality.

The Baldwin Town Board left at 7:53 p.m. while the Park Committee continued on with their regular monthly meeting.
