REQUEST FOR MNDOT SPEED ZONE STUDY ON 96th STREET COMMENCING AT THE INTERSECTION OF 96th STREET AND 277th AVENUE, CONTINUING NORTH ON 96th STREET TO 289th AVENUE (SHERBURNE COUNTY ROAD 28) AND THERE ENDING

WHEREAS, this minor arterial/collector roadway serves an increasingly number of residents due to recent and scheduled subdivision plats, and

WHEREAS, a reduced speed limit to 45 mph is believed to be in the best interest of residents for their safety, now




