**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY  
PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 300  
ON EMERGENCY ADDRESS IDENTIFICATION**

**WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2011, the Town Board of Baldwin Township adopted an ordinance To Establish Emergency Address Identification - Ordinance No. 300 (the "Ordinance");

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes, section 365.125, subdivision 2 and Minnesota Statutes, section 368.01, subdivision 21 allow the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the entire ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board determines publishing the entire text of the Ordinance is impractical and that publication of a summary of the Ordinance is sufficient to clearly inform the public its intent and effect.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby decides to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

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**BALDWIN TOWNSHIP  
Ordinance No. 300**

**TO ESTABLISH EMERGENCY  
ADDRESS IDENTIFICATION**

The Town Board adopted Ordinance No. 300 related to emergency address identification. The ordinance requires properties to be identified with a sign meeting certain specifications, placed at the property entrance, and indicating the property's identification (address) number. Existing homes are required to comply with this ordinance as well as newly developed properties. Owners are required to maintain the identification signs and to keep them clear of obstructions. The ordinance is effective immediately and prescribes penalties for violations. A copy of the entire ordinance is available for inspection at the Town Hall, the Princeton Public Library, the town's website, and a copy may be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk-Treasurer.


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
**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to:
