**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE TOWN'S EMERGENCY ADDRESS
IDENTIFICATION ORDINANCE No. 300**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Supervisors (the "Town Board") of Baldwin Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota (the "Town") adopted Ordinance No. 300 at its meeting on September 12, 2011 establishing an emergency address identification ordinance for the Town (the "Ordinance");

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to amend the policy by deleting the assessment portion of the Ordinance by deleting the strikethrough language as follows:


Obtaining Signs Fees. ~~To bring existing homes (those constructed prior to the effective date of the Ordinance) into compliance with this new ordinance, and to effectively save property owners on the cost of the minimum signage necessary to comply with this ordinance, the sign, post, bolts, and installation will be assessed to each property. If any structure remains unnumbered, the owners must contact the Town Hall within 30 days after the Township completes the installation to request a sign.~~

Effective Date. This amendment to the Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the town clerk/treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to file this Resolution in the Town's records, incorporate the amendment into the Policy and to make copies of the amended Ordinance available to the public upon request in accordance with its terms and conditions.


