RESOLUTION NO. 13-01

RESOLUTON ADOPTING SIGN RETRO-REFLECTIVITY
AND REPLACEMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration has initiated Section 2A.08 of the Manual on Uniform Control Devices mandating sign retro-reflectivity standards and the replacement of all non-conforming signage statewide.

WHEREAS, no funding has been allocated to Baldwin Township for the implementation of these mandated standards.

WHEREAS, Baldwin Township has 80 miles of roads.

WHEREAS, the MNDOT standards and estimates indicate an average of 6 signs per mile.

WHEREAS, the development of housing and commercial areas has necessitated what the Town Board believes is consistent with that average or more across the Township.


WHEREAS, the financial concern of a full scale implementation to replace all signs and non-conforming hardware at one time is deemed to be an unfeasible burden to place on the Township's budget or the residents of Baldwin Township.


WHEREAS, through standard maintenance practices, substandard signs are already being replaced with conforming signs and hardware in Baldwin Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Baldwin Township shall continue to, upon signage repairs or new road construction, replace all signs with materials and hardware conforming to Section 2A.08 of the Manual on Uniform Control Devices. As replacements take place emphasis will be placed on reducing the amount or type of signs where deemed applicable.
